- It's CHARACTER before CONDUCT





"Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God."

- I. The Context
  - Matthew 5:8 requires an "inside job"
  - What is God's Standard
    - I Peter 1:16 "For the Scriptures say,
       'You must be holy because I am holy."
    - Matthew 5:48 "But you are to be perfect, even as your Father in heaven is perfect."

#### II. The Position

- Where does God look as He observes a man?
  - I Samuel 16:7 "But the Lord said to Samuel, 'Don't judge by his appearance or height, for I have rejected him. The Lord doesn't see things the way you see them. People judge by outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart."

- III. The Meaning
  - The world system says: Blessed are the...
    - Adult
    - Sophisticated
    - Broad-minded

- A. "Heart"
  - The heart, Biblically speaking, is the seat of the mind, will and emotions
    - It refers primarily to the mind (thinking)
       and will (decisions)

- Proverbs 23:7 They are always thinking about how much it costs. "Eat and drink," they say, but they don't mean it.
- Proverbs 4:23 Guard your heart above all else, for it determines the course of your life.

- 1. The Physical Heart
  - It is crucial to life.
  - If it goes out, you go out!
- 2. The Spiritual Heart
  - Jeremiah 17:9
  - Mark 7:15, 21, 22
  - Psalm 51:10


"The human heart is the most deceitful of all things, and desperately wicked. Who really knows how bad it is?"



Create in me a clear heart, O God. Renew a loyal spirit within me.

#### The Human Heart

- A powerful muscle
- Pumps blood
- With each compression, it pumps 2-2.5 ounces of blood
- 70 beats per minute
- Pumps 4-5 quarts per minute
- In 70 years, beats 2.5 billion times plus 165 million quarts of blood
- Weights ½ pound
- Size = clinched fist





- B. Pure
  - Jesus is saying:

I desire a heart that is unmixed in its devotion and motivation. Pure motives from a pure heart.

#### B. Pure

- Pure means "singleness of heart"
- Pure in heart means "utterly sincere"

  - A. Receive Jesus Christ into your life
    - When you do, you are given:
      - Positional purity
      - Actual purity
  - B. Decide to Follow Jesus
  - C. Desire practical purity

But if we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness.


