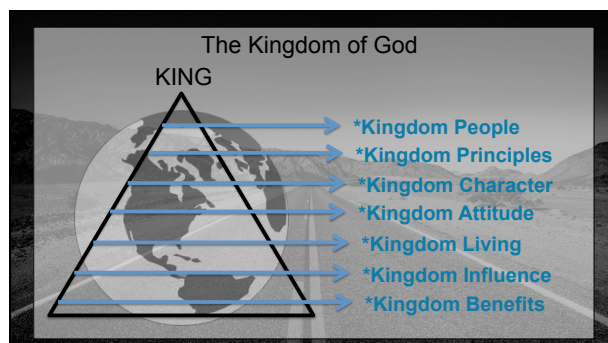

How do I become poor in Spirit?

How do I become poor in Spirit?

1. See your spiritual bankruptcy
 - You must see that on your own, you cannot reach God.
 - You must see that you are spiritually dead. (Ephesians 2:1)

How do I become poor in Spirit?

2. You must see that only Jesus Christ can meet our problem of Spiritual Bankruptcy.
3. You must admit your desperate need for Jesus Christ.
4. You must become a dependent person.
