


The world's definition of a happy person is the opposite of Jesus' definition.


I Peter 5:10

2. How will we be harassed?


Matthew 5:11

- Persecution and suffering comes to everyone, without discrimination.

3. Why will we be persecuted?

Not all suffering has apparent value.
 Jesus tells us in Matthew 5:10-12 what the right causes are to be persecuted.

3. Why will we be persecuted?

A. "Because of righteousness (v. 10)

- B. "Because of me" (v. 11)
 - The world will hate you if you truly follow Christ. John 15:18-19

C. Because of the rejection of Christ's standard.

- 4. How can we avoid persecution?
 - A. Approve the world's standards
 - Be proud don't admit your needs.
 - Be tough don't mourn.
 - Be a "know-it-all" not meek.
 - Be a grabber not a giver
 - Be cold-hearted not merciful.
 - Be good but not proud
 - Be a truce maker not a peacemaker
